



## Y3 Curriculum Information Term 3:2 Hakuna Matata!



### ENGLISH TOPICS

**Fiction:** Pupils will read a variety of texts as well as write their own adventure stories.

**Non-Fiction:** Pupils will research different facts about Africa and look more closely at Ghana itself.

In spellings we will continue to work in groups working on Read write inc spellings. Please encourage your child to practice the spellings we send out each week as they are tested on a Friday.

### MATHS

This half term, we will be focussing on: Number and Place Value (comparing, ordering and presenting numbers), Multiplication (arrays and grid method) and Division (grouping and bus stop method), Fractions ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{3}$ ), Geometry (properties of 2D and 3D shapes) and Data Handling.

#### **Science: Light**

Pupils will learn that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light. They will also learn that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.

#### **Geography- Ghana**

Pupils will locate Ghana on a map, compare it's climate to that of England's and understand the importance of Ghana's natural resources.

#### **Computing: Email**

Children will learn how to send Emails using Purple Mash. They will also learn about E safety

#### **R.E- Why is Jesus so inspiring?**

Children will learn and understand how Siddhartha Gautama came to be known as Buddha and they will be able to explain the meaning of a Buddhist parable

#### **French: Food**

Children will learn how to say specific food in French. They may even get to taste some French cuisine!
