Dear Parents

RE: MURTON PARK

As part of the history curriculum for the autumn term, all Year 5 children will be learning about World War 2. To expand the children's understanding of this aspect of the curriculum, we have arranged for the whole of Year 5 to visit Murton Park 'The Homefront' in York where they will work in small groups alongside site guides, teachers and support assistants. Each class will visit the centre on separate days, which are as follows:

**Wed 7 November - 5G, Thurs 8 November - 5D, Fri 9 November - 5U, Mon 12 November - 5P**

The subsidised cost of the trip will be £24.00 per child to cover the cost of transport and entrance to the centre. The children will leave at 9.00 a.m. and will arrive back at school at approximately **4.15 p.m.** depending on traffic. Due to our late return, you will need to make arrangements for the safe journey home of your child. Please indicate on the attached pro forma how your child will get home.

Your child will need a packed lunch, unless he/she is entitled to a free school meal, in which case a packed lunch can be provided. However, if your child receives a free school meal but you wish to provide your own, could you please indicate this on the pro forma. Your child may take a drink should they wish to do so. If your child uses an inhaler, this should also be taken.

In order for your child to get into the character of a WW2 child, we should be grateful if you could organise an appropriate costume for your child to wear during the visit. We suggest therefore, that the boys wear a white shirt, a tie, tailored shorts, knee socks and school shoes together with either a knitted cardigan or tank top. If you have a flat cap available this would finish off their costume. The girls can wear a gingham dress or similar, a knitted cardigan, knee socks and school shoes. If you have a beret or headscarf this would enhance the girl's costume.

In order for your child to participate in this visit, can you please complete the attached pro forma and return it to your child's class teacher. Should you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact school.
