Ideas to support learning

Milk Bottle Tops Game:

- 1. Collect 26 plastic milk bottle tops. Write a letter of the alphabet on each one. (A sharpie pen is good for this!)
- 2. Lay the lids out in the order of the alphabet (your child should be able to help with this after some practise!)
- 3. Ask your child to spell each word in turn.
- 4. The child picks up the correct lids and spells out the word sounding out each letter in turn

Finger Tracing Game:

- 1. Sit your child in front of you on the floor/stool.
- 2. Trace one letter of the alphabet onto their back with your finger.
- 3. Your child has to recognise and name the letter.
- 4. Now try the rest of the letters to spell the given word.
- 5. Can your child tell you which word you have written.
- 6. Now let your child write a spelling on your back.
- 7. Can they spell it correctly?

Fred Fingers:

- 1. Give your child a word from their list.
- 2. Ask them how many sounds it is made from.
- 3. Can they show you by using one finger per sound (see picture)
- 4. After sounding out each letter, close the fingers together and say the whole word. Remember some sounds are made from 2 letters e.g. 'ay'.
