Term 1:1

The Flintstones



ENGLISH TOPICS

- Poetry:** Pupils will create Calligram (shape) poems about Remembrance Day.
- Fiction:** Pupils will read 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura, which will inspire our Stone Age topic and lead to creative portal story writing.
- Non Fiction:** Pupils will learn to write a survival guide during the Stone Age.
- Homework:** Children should read to an adult at least 3 times a week.
Spellings should be practised throughout the half term.

MATHS

This half term, we will be focussing on: number and place value (read and write numbers, recognise place value, comparing and ordering numbers), addition (partitioning method) and subtraction (partitioning method), Fractions (recognise and write fractions, tenths, add and subtract fractions), measures (money, length, mass, volume and capacity), Statistics (interpret and present data, tally charts, bar charts and pictograms) and perimeter (calculate and measure perimeter).

Homework: Children should complete their homework each week at home or they will be expected to attend homework club on Tuesday.

Art: Cave painting and Clay artefacts

We will be learning about Stone Age cave painting and creating our own. We will also be making our own clay artefacts.

French: Un/une and greetings.

Children will build their understanding of feminine and masculine words. Children will also be practising simple greetings.

Computing:

Children will be learning how to use the internet safely. They will be taught to scan QR codes.

History: The Stone Age

We will be learning about the Stone Age. Children will build Stonehenge using different materials.

R.E: Christianity

Children will learn about the Christmas story and will make a Christingle. We will be celebrating a Christingle service at our local church. We will also be visiting our local church to learn about Christian symbols and the church environment.
