Town Planners

ENGLISH TOPICS

- Poetry:** Pupils will create Calligram (shape poems) about Remembrance Day.
- Fiction:** Pupils will read Paddington Bear and create an adventure story!
- Non Fiction:** Pupils will write a letter to Greenpeace based on the story 'Dear Greenpeace'
- Homework:** Children should read to an adult at least 3 times a week.
Spellings should be practised throughout the half term.

MATHS

This half term, we will be focussing on: Number and Place Value (comparing, ordering and presenting numbers), Multiplication (arrays and grid method) and division (grouping and number lines), Fractions ($\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$), Measures (time), Geometry (Properties of shapes) and Data Handling.

Homework: Children should complete their mental maths and Calculation homework each week.

Art: Cityscapes

Children will explore, create and evaluate different cityscape patterns.

French: Un/une and greetings.

Children will build their understanding of feminine and masculine words.
Children will also be practising simple greetings.

Computing:

Children will be learning how to use the internet safely. They will be taught to use word processor.

Geography: Comparing Castleford and London

We will be learning about our local area as well as London and comparing similarities and differences.

R.E: Christianity

Pupils will be learning about a range of Christian stories. They will also learn to listen to other's thoughts!
