ENGLISH TOPICS

Non-Fiction: Pupils will research and write an information leaflet about plants.

Narrative: Pupils will create a story of their own based off the book "The Tin Forest"

Homework: Children should read to an adult at least 3 times a week. Spellings should be practised every week. Times tables

MATHS

This half term, we will be focussing on: Number and Place Value (comparing, ordering and presenting numbers), Multiplication (arrays and grid method) and Division (grouping and bus stop method), Fractions ($1/2$, $1/4$ and $1/3$), Geometry (properties of 2D and 3D shapes) and Data Handling.

Homework: Children should complete their Mental maths, times-tables and spellings homework each week

Science: Plants

Pupils will learn what plants need to help them grow. They will learn to name each part of a plant and the job each part does. They will learn the lifecycle of plants including how and why pollination takes place. Children will also be taking part in lots of practical, hands on tasks!

ICT: Key Skills

Children learn how to control a beebot. This includes understanding special awareness and use of clear concise directions.

Children will learn about Why people pray and how this happens in different religions.

Art: Collaborative Work

Children will be designing and building a mini greenhouse using wood!
