Roman Britain



ENGLISH TOPICS

Non Fiction: Pupils will write their own non fiction text related to our science topic.

Fiction: Pupils will be writing poetry related to our topic this half term as well as writing their own Roman narrative.

As part of this topic children will be researching their own facts about Roman Britain and creating a range of non-fiction texts related to this topic.

MATHS

A range of maths topics will be covered over the course of the year. This half term, we will be focussing on: Number and place value (Reading and writing, estimating and presenting numbers), Multiplication and Division (Grid method and number lines), Fractions, Time (using an analogue clock) and Geometry (Shape).

Science: Light

Pupils will learn about light sources and the absence of light. We will be investigating shadows and reflections. Children will also learn about sun safety.

Art: Clay lamps

Investigating, designing and making their own Roman clay lamps.

Pupils will be learning about why people pray.

Music:

Children will learning a song called 'Bringing us together'. They will move on to performing the song and eventually play an instrument along with the song.

French:

Learn French phrases for conversations. They will listen carefully to pronunciation learn to speak the French words.

Geography

Children will be learning all about the Roman Britain and the impact that the Romans had on our country.
